1. Completed Award Application
2. Submission Materials for Just Review (a single PDF file on 8-1/2"x11" format in 11 pt font, not to exceed twelve pages, in the order listed below)
3. Announcement Images: provide a zipped folder containing the following landscape .jpeg image files, 3200 pixels wide x 1800 pixels tall and a minimum of 72 dpi. Should your image not meet these qualifications it will not be displayed by AIANJ.
  - a. (1) One black and white photograph of the candidate
  - b. (3) Three images from your application that showcase the candidate's service to the profession
4. Copyright image page(s) as described in Appendix A

*Submission Materials for Jury Review*

1. **Nomination Letter:** One page summary of the candidate's contributions.
2. **Candidate Biography and Leadership Credentials:** One page containing the Candidate Statement, list of offices, positions, honors, publications, and presentations related to the purpose of the award.
3. **Summary of Accomplishments:** (two pages) including a personal narrative illustrating the candidate's service to the profession, how the candidate's work has advanced design, practice, or education; enhanced the profession through active engagement; and benefitted the communities with volunteer efforts.
4. **Exhibits:** Maximum of two pages each with images, drawings, or other materials that demonstrate the candidate's accomplishments. A maximum of six (6) exhibits may be submitted.
5. **Two (2) Reference Letters** meeting the following criteria:
  - One page (two page letters will be removed from your file and not reviewed by the jury)
  - On company letterhead
  - Signed

Any submission that does not conform to the requirements as stated above will not be considered.
